**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DEPARTMENT 1:**

1. All stalls will be assigned by Superintendent(s) in charge.
2. All cattle entered, except where otherwise specified, must be eligible to register in a recognized Herd Book. Exhibitors must furnish certificates of registry for all animals over one year of age and also certificate of transfer when not bred by exhibitor, if requested to do so by the Superintendent.
3. No animal shall be shown in more than one section except in classes Get of Sire, Produce of Dam, Herds, Championships and Special Classes.
4. First and second prize winners only can compete for championship prizes.
5. Senior Champions are animals over two years of age and Junior Champions are animals under two years of age.
6. Animals may be shown for both single and herd premiums. Where but one firm or individual is exhibiting in any class, but two premiums will be awarded, with the right reserved to award premiums according to the merit of animals shown. A decision as to how many individuals or firms are exhibiting shall be in the hands of the Superintendent and his/her decision is final.
7. **Any changes in classes have to be made no later than 5:00 p.m., Monday, first day of fair. All entries are final and changes cannot be made the day of show. Entries will be checked by the Superintendent in charge.**

**GROUP CLASS**

15. Three Best Females - all three females must be bred and at least one owned by exhibitor. Two must be senior females and the third any age.
16. Produce of Dam - two offspring, any age, from the same dam. May be owned by more than one exhibitor.
17. Dam and Daughter - any cow and one of her female offspring, any age. May be owned by more than one exhibitor.
18. Breeders Herd - five females, all owned by exhibitor. Group to consist of two females over 2 years of age, two females under 2 years of age, and one any age. Three must be bred by exhibitor.
