In Order to provide a more uniform poultry project, the following guidelines will be in effect as suggested by M.S.U.

1. All poultry and waterfowl for Meat Pen Production will be purchased from a designated supplier announced by the Poultry Superintendents. A maximum of 10 birds per project may be purchased. 5 of the original birds purchased will be wing tagged the 3rd Sunday in July, from 10am—12 noon. See rule #8 on page 11. 3 birds from the 5 wing tagged are eligible for entry into the Fair.
2. The Poultry Superintendent will accept orders only for 4-H projects. Families or members wishing to purchase more birds other than the project birds may do so by contacting the designated supplier direct.
3. All breeds will be sexed at purchase at the discretion of the Superintendent.

All aisles will be cleaned daily by exhibitors or Clubs!!

RULES FOR DEPARTMENT 12:

1. Meat Pens must be hatched after January 1st of the current year.
2. Educational Exhibits are to be entered in DEPARTMENT 82 - Educational Projects/Veterinary Science.

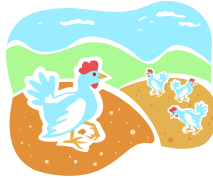

SECTION 2 - MARKET FOWL

CLASS:

1. Chicken Fryers - 8 weeks or under, 3 cockerels or 3 pullets
2. Chicken Roasters - 9 to 16 weeks old, 3 cockerels or 3 hens
3. Turkey Meat Birds - 14 - 24 weeks old, 3 toms or 3 hens
4. Ducks - 3 meat birds under 6 months.
5. Geese - 3 meat birds under 6 months

SECTION 3 - SWEEPSTAKES

Do not enter in Classes 1 thru 4

RULES:

1. Sweepstakes Awards are made by selection .
2. First and second place market fowl will be eligible to sell at the 4-H Livestock Sale.
3. Eligibility will be determined by the Judge.
4. Poultry Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected from classes one and two combined.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASS:

1. Best of Show/**from SECTION 1** – Trophy & Rosette
2. Reserve Best of Show/**from SECTION 1** – Rosette
3. Champion Pen of 3 Meat Birds from SECTION 2, classes 1,2, 3, 4 and 5 - Rosette & Trophy
4. Reserve Champion Pen of Meat Birds from SECTION 2 classes 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 - Rosette

SECTION 4 - SHOWMANSHIP

CLASS:

1. Poultry Showmanship (ages 15 & over) - Rosette & Trophy
2. Poultry Showmanship (ages 12, 13 & 14) - Rosette & Trophy
3. Poultry Showmanship (ages 9, 10 & 11) - Rosette & Trophy

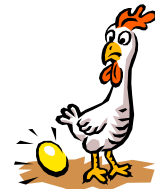
SECTION 5—CLUB BARN DISPLAY
