RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DEPARTMENT 17:

1. All entries must be accompanied with a negative Coggins Test, dated no earlier than 1-1-10.
2. The age of horses shall be computed from January 1.
3. Horses may be shown in halter and performance classes.
4. Where but one firm or individual is exhibiting in any class but two premiums will be awarded, with the right reserved to award premiums according to the merit of the animals shown. A decision as to how many individuals to firms are exhibiting shall be left entirely in the hands of the Superintendents of the department and his/her decision is final.
5. Grade stallions will not be allowed to compete in any class.
6. All horses entered except where otherwise specified, must be eligible to entry in a recognized stud book. Exhibitors must be prepared to furnish Certificate of Registry of all animals over one year of age if requested to do so by the Superintendent.
7. Horses of different breeds cannot compete for the same breeders prize.
8. Horses must not leave stables without permission of the Superintendent, except for judging or at parades. Any violation of this ruling will be forfeiture of premiums and dismissal.
9. All stallions must be shown by exhibitor age 16 years or over.
10. Straw and/or shavings can be used for bedding.

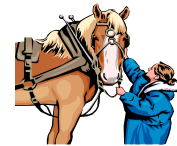

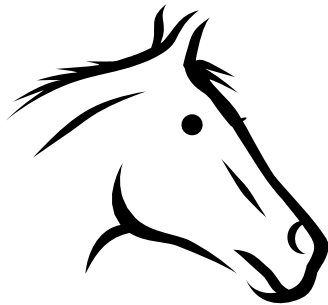
