RULES FOR DEPARTMENT 28:

1. A 4-H youth can show in any class however, **three (3) classes will be paid premiums.** Other classes will receive only ribbons. If a member is registered as a novice on May 1st, he/she must show in novice classes only.
2. Trailers will not be allowed to sit outside of gate and used for tack. Superintendents will designate parking.
3. All horses must be exercised before 11:00 a.m. in designated areas, unless pre-arranged with Armada Fair Superintendent.
4. All horses must be led at a walk to and from barns to show arena. Horses are not allowed in food areas and in front of the horse barn.
5. A 5-minute tack change will be allowed when necessary.
6. More than one exhibitor may share a horse, but an exhibitor may only show one horse. Exhibitors sharing horses do not have to be siblings and horses do not need to be registered in the exhibitor's name. Family ownership or leasing of project horses is encouraged, but not required.
7. Classes will be judged according to Michigan 4-H standards, as stated by the American Mini Horse Association.
8. Education Exhibits are to be entered in DEPARTMENT 82 - Educational Projects/Veterinary Science.
9. A member will need to be registered with the Macomb County 4-H Horse Recording Secretary on May 1, of the current year as well as registered per Macomb County 4-H regulations for showing at Armada Fair.
10. \$10.00 will be withheld from your premium check, if stalls are not clean and a release form signed.
11. 4-H Youth is responsible for preparing their horse for all classes.
12. Educational/Demonstration Projects: Eligible for youth 18 years old and under as of Jan. 1, of current fair year. If 20 years of age and entered in any class, entire class is ineligible for funding.
13. Dress Code in effect: Exhibitors must wear show/dress pants, dress shirts or blouses, boots and must be neat and clean.
14. **All horses must have a negative Coggins test dated no earlier than January 1, of the calendar year.**
15. **The following listing of classes IS NOT THE ORDER OF JUDGING! A show bill will be provided day of show!**
