RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DEPARTMENT 3:

1. All stalls will be assigned by the Superintendent(s) in charge.
2. All cattle entered, except where otherwise specified, must be the true property of exhibitor at the time of entry.
3. All cattle entered, except where otherwise specified, must be eligible to register in a recognized Herd Book. Exhibitors must furnish certificates of registry for all animals over one year of age and also certificate of transfer when not bred by exhibitor, if requested to do so by the Superintendent.
4. No animal shall be shown in more than one section except in classes for Get of Sire, Produce of Dam, Herds, Championships and Special Classes.
5. First and second prize winners only can compete for championship prizes.
6. Senior Champions are animals over two years of age, Junior Champions are animals under two years of age.
7. Animals must be shown for both single and herd premiums. Where but one firm or individual is exhibiting in any class, but two premiums will be awarded, with the right reserved to award premiums according to the merit of the animals shown. A decision as to how many individuals or firms are exhibiting shall be left entirely in the hands of the Superintendent of the department and his/her decision is final.
8. **All Bulls in classes 16 through 22** must have at least one nose ring restraint with lead to enter the show ring.

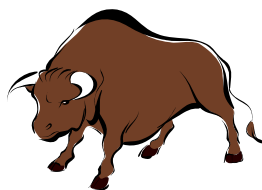

GROUP CLASSES:

23. Pair of Calves - Bull from classes 12 thru 15 both sexes represented/Female from classes 1 to 4
24. Pair of Yearlings - Bull from classes 16 thru 20, both sexes represented/Female from classes 5 thru 9
25. Pair of Females - Bred and owned by the exhibitor any age from classes 1 thru 11.
26. Pair of Bulls - Bred and owned by exhibitor, any age from classes 12 thru 22.
27. Three Females - Owned by the exhibitor, any age from classes 1 thru 11.
28. Three Bulls - Owned by the exhibitor, any age from classes 12 thru 22.
29. Cow/Calf - Calf any age, either sex
30. Sr. Get Of Sire - Owned by exhibitor, 4 animals any age, both sexes represented.
31. Produce of Dam - 2 offspring, either sex from same Dam. May be owned by more than one exhibitor.
32. Breeders Herd - 3 head, both sexes represented.
