RULES FOR DEPARTMENT 4:

1. Steers eligible for Junior Division must have been on feed and owned by the 4-H member since February 1st of current year.
2. The Club Herd of three steers may include any breed and must be shown by three exhibitors, minimum two families.
3. Educational exhibits are to be entered in DEPARTMENT 82 - Educational Projects/ Veterinary Science.
4. Indicate breed on entry form for Section 1 - Breeding Animals. Breeds will be judged separately.
5. If a class number exceeds ten the class may be divided into equal groups for run-off where judge can select three from each group for final class winner.
6. Participation in SECTION 3—Beef Showmanship is mandatory for all entered in Dept 4.
7. The Exhibitor as named MUST be present whenever animal is removed from pen, unless prior arrangement is made with Fair Board Superintendent.
8. Refer to dress code on page 10, rule #6.

SECTION 1 - BREEDING ANIMALS

PREMIUMS - SECTION 1, CLASSES 1, 2, & 3:

A - \$7.50 B - \$6.50 C - \$5.00

CLASS:

1. Heifer calves calved between September 1, 2009 and August 31, 2009.
2. Summer Yearling Heifers calved between May 1, 2009 and August 31, 2009.
3. Junior Yearling Heifers calved between January 1, 2009 and April 30, 2009.

PREMIUMS - SECTION 2 CLASSES 4, 5 & 6:

A - \$9.00 B - \$7.50 C - \$6.00

CLASS:

4. Sr. Yearling Heifer calved between September 1, 2008 and December 31, 2008.
5. Two year old Heifer calved between May 1, 2008 and August 31, 2008.
6. Female born prior to May 1, 2008.

GROUP CLASS:

7. Club Herd - Rosette
8. Two females, any age, owned by exhibitor - Rosette

RULES:

1. All showmanship animals must be shown in their respective class.

CLASS

1. Senior Showmanship (age 15 & over) - Rosette & Trophy
2. Intermediate Showmanship (ages 12 13 & 14) - Rosette & Trophy
3. Junior Showmanship (ages 9 10 & 11) - Rosette & Trophy
4. Most Pounds Gained (The first Sunday in February to the entry day of the present Armada Fair) - Rosette & Trophy
5. Overall Showmanship - Rosette

SECTION 5 - KLUSENDORF AWARD

DO NOT ENTER INTO THIS SECTION

RULES:

1. Any contestants who placed first in the Senior, Intermediate and Junior levels in Beef, Sheep, Swine and Market Goat Showmanship are eligible.
