9. Antiques must be 50 years old and not shown during the **prior three years.** Any Antique shown at the 2009 Armada Fair will not be eligible for a premium until the 2012 Armada Fair. Per State Regulation #810.
10. Any printed antiques i.e. Magazines, newspapers, etc. must be original print works. **No copies or reproductions.**
