1. Seeds to be present years growth (except grass seed and corn) and to be raised and owned by exhibitor.
2. All seeds to be properly labeled and sealed in one pint jar with entry tag attached on outside of bag.
3. Place all ears on a plate in a zip lock bag or box.
4. All root balls must be bagged.

**Learning Objective:** Promoting creativity, artistry sculpture and painting techniques.

**CLASS**

1. Sculptured and/or painted Pumpkin or Gourd of Faces, of famous People or Cartoon Characters.
  - a. No cutting of pumpkin or gourd allowed.
  - b. Any materials may be used.
  - c. Identification tag of character must be attached.
  - d. Will be judged according to their creativity and attractiveness and resemblance to character.
2. Seeds
  - a. An artistic design, picture or mural, made with any variety of seeds, on any hard surfaced material. (No other materials may be used).
  - b. Seeds may be left in their natural appearance or tinted.
  - c. No frame required.
  - d. Size: No smaller than 10" x 13" and no larger than 13" x 20".
3. Two birds made out of any variety of dried gourds. May be painted.
4. A birdhouse made out of a dried gourd. Can be stained, varnished, or painted. Must have hook to hang.
