3. Flowers are to be brought in watered. Exhibitor's cannot water exhibit(s) after entry has been made. Use of Floral Foam such as Oasis is recommended, but needs to hold adequate water and not tip over in the wind.
4. Flowers may be replaced to make them attractive by permission of Superintendent.
5. Amateurs only are permitted to enter their work in competition, unless otherwise stated. Amateurs are those who do not sell for profit and whose exhibit represents a recreational hobby.
6. Fresh flowers are to be outdoor grown and *no lightweight containers.* Containers are not judged. **No Styrofoam or plastic Cups accepted.**
7. Superintendent in charge reserves the right to place entries in another class if appropriate.
8. **No arrangements are to be entered from previous years.**

CLASS

1. "Behind the Barn" - a wall plaque arrangement of dried material on a barn board.
2. "Country Christmas" - crescent shaped, using evergreen and one or more candles.
3. "Country Courting" - an arrangement using roses.
4. "Country Fair" A One sided arrangement featuring a Horseshoe.
5. "Country Hospitality" - L-shaped arrangement in a kitchen container.
6. "Country is..." - using leaves.
7. "Country Wedding" - a flower girl bouquet in a wicker basket, ribbon allowed.
8. "Farm Pond" - wild flowers.
9. "Gingham Garden" - round arrangement of cheerful flowers, incorporating gingham.
10. "Good Neighbors" - miniature floral arrangement under 5" in any direction.
