RULES FOR DEPARTMENT 6:

1. All sheep need to be owned by member on or before June 1st of exhibit year.
2. Purebred, Grade or Cross-Bred wether or ewe lambs of any of the mutton breeds are eligible for Market Lamb classes. The Pen of Market Lambs must be owned by one 4-H youth member.
3. Members may show no more than one pen of lambs, one lamb from their pen as single lamb.
4. Educational Exhibits are to be entered in DEPARTMENT 82 - Educational Projects/ Veterinary Science.
5. Market Lambs that do not show a weight gain between tagging and weigh-in at the fair will be placed in a special class.
6. If a showmanship class number exceeds ten, the class may be divided into equal groups for run-off where judge can select three from each group for final class winner.
7. Sheep must be brought out of pens to be judged to receive a premium. **The Exhibitor as named MUST be present whenever animal is removed from pen, unless prior arrangement is made with Fair Board Superintendent.**
8. Wool breeds may be bedded on straw. Bedding needs to be replaced everyday and chips cleaned every other day.
9. Tail must be lift able.
10. Participation in SECTION 1—Sheep Showmanship is mandatory for all entered in Dept 6.
11. Refer to dress code on Page 10, Rule #6.

SECTION 1- SHEEP SHOWMANSHIP

RULES:

1. All showmanship animals must be shown in their respective class.

CLASS:

1. Sr. Showmanship (ages 15 & over) - Rosette & Trophy
2. Int. Showmanship (ages 12, 13 & 14) - Rosette & Trophy
3. Jr. Showmanship (ages 9, 10 & 11) - Rosette & Trophy
4. Most Pounds Gained (From the second Sunday in June to entry day of present Armada Fair) - Rosette & Trophy
5. Overall Showmanship - Rosette & Trophy

SECTION 2 - KLUSENDORF AWARD **DO NOT ENTER INTO THIS CLASS**

RULES:

1. Any contestants who placed first in the Senior, Intermediate and Junior levels in Beef, Sheep, Swine and Market Goat Showmanship are eligible.

CLASS:

1. Klusendorf Showmanship Award - Trophy

SECTION 3-FLEECE

CLASS:

1. Fleece. Shorn fleece from one animal tied with paper twine. Entry should indicate long, medium or fine fleece.

5. Overweight Individual Lamb
6. Underweight Pen
7. Overweight Pen
8. No Weight Gain Individual
9. No Weight Gain Pen
