RULES:

2. Each club shows one poster not larger than 3'x 4' and one notebook of 10 pages or less. These will be judged together.
3. Rubric for judging:
 - a) Originality/Creativity – 20%
 - b) Description of Community Service– 20%
 - c) Promotion of 4-H – 25%
 - d) Educational Content – 25%
 - e) Theme Expression Effectively – 5%
 - f) Names & Photos of Club Members – 5%
4. Displays in place by 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the opening of Fair, unless other arrangements have been made with the Superintendent.

Rules:

1. Leaders must enter the Barn Display Section under each individual species, in the individual departments.
2. See individual Dept. Superintendent for specific placement of displays in barns.
3. Rubric for Judging:
 - A. Names & Photos of club members—10%
 - B. Educational content—20%
 - C. Promotion of 4-H—10%
 - D. Cleanliness & Care of Animal—20%
 - E. Aisle, Stall & Area Cleanliness—20%
 - F. Originality/Creativity—10%
 - G. Theme expressed effectively—10%
4. Barn Displays will be judged on the Species' show day.

Learning Objective: This program allows 4-H teens the opportunity to represent Macomb County 4-H and the community by sharing what they have learned and gained from the 4-H program.

RULES:

1. 4-H nominees must be 14 to 18 & completed a minimum two (2) years in 4-H, not including current year.
2. Each registered club can nominate one male and one female from their club.
3. Must complete King/Queen application form on 4-H County website to be eligible and turn into the Extension Office by 2nd Friday in June.
4. **Nominations must be turned into the fair office by the 4-H CLUB LEADER under Dept. 81 by the fair deadline.**
5. Candidates are interviewed on their 4-H experience by a panel of judges prior to the Fair. Court members are judged on both the interview and application.
6. Court members are to be present fair week for scheduled duties such as Petting Farm, Exhibit Bldg., handing out ribbons or Clover Sprout judging.
7. Must be willing to represent 4-H throughout the year including participation in local parades and 4-H County activities.
8. Must be willing to help with making the parade float.
9. Record/Scrapbook, project photos, special awards and recognitions are to be displayed in the 4-H Exhibit Bldg during Fair week.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES & CLUBS:

1. Candidates and 4-H club members may campaign for their Candidate choice.
2. Candidates may put up campaign posters at the 4-H Exhibit Bldg in an area designated by the Superintendent.
3. All registered 4-H members can vote for their Candidate choice during scheduled voting times at a specified location. Court members will receive additional points. additional points towards their score based on 4-H members' votes. Each 4-H member is allowed one (1) vote.
4. Crowning of winners, runners-up and court will take place During Opening Ceremonies of Fair, Monday August 16 at 6:00 pm on the Main Stage.
