2. More than one entry may be made within a Section, with **a maximum of two (2) entries per class.**
3. Food will be displayed as directed in individual classes. Item exhibited must be made or grown by the individual.
4. Foods will not be tasted, but judged only on texture and/or appearance
5. Box mixes are allowed and please attach a copy of the recipe to each food item.
6. All items must be on a paper place in a zip lock bag with entry tag attached to the outside.
