RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DEPARTMENT 88:

- 1. More than one entry may be made within a section, but only a maximum of one entry per class.
2. All entry tags attached to OUTSIDE of bag.

SECTION 1 - HOME GARDEN

CLASS

- 1. Mini-garden - An exhibit of 5 items on one plate of 3 different vegetables from a garden no larger than 200 sq. ft. A sketch, diagram or garden plan must accompany the vegetable exhibit. If pod vegetables are included, 4 pods required.
2. Container Garden - No more than 10 gallon size. Use container required for a mini-garden.
3. Recyclable Container/Garden or Garbage Can Gardening. No more than 15 gallon size. Use fruit and vegetable plants in throw away containers.
4. Educational Exhibit - An exhibit presenting science information or proper production practices. Such as variety trails, fertilizer trails, spray control tests, weed control tests or any other experiment planned. (Limit 48" wide x 30" deep x 36" high). Notebooks or work-books if displayed must be a part of a total exhibit including other item or items.
5. Best Youth Organization Display - Vegetable Garden
a. This exhibit consists of 10 or more vegetable displays covering not more than 4' x 6'. One exhibit per youth organization OR
b. This exhibit should consist of vegetables all in one family (6 or more). One exhibit per youth organization. 48"x36" OR
c. Youth Organization Scarecrow - size 4' tall x 24" deep. All parts must be attached. No loose props.

SECTION 2 - VEGETABLES

RULES:

- 1. All exhibits will be displayed on 8" or 9" plates in zip lock bag or cardboard box no larger than 16" long and 10" wide, by 4" high.
2. All vegetables to be topped no more than 1" in length, with entry tag attached to outside of bag.
3. Include 3x5 card indicating when planted, growing cycle etc.
