RULES FOR DEPARTMENT 2:

1. Beginners will exhibit 1 animal, intermediate members may exhibit 2 animals and advanced members may exhibit 3 animals.
2. Produce of Dam shall consist of two animals, any age, owned by a 4-H member and raised as a project from his/her club cow.
3. Registrations and transfers must be completed by May 1st. All participants must have proof of ownership by May 1st if animal is not registered - 2 year old and over by January 1.
4. **Production Record Class** - This class may be entered in addition to the regular class of cows in milk. Additional premiums will be paid on the basis of production, regardless of position in the regular class. The production record covering a lactation period of at least 10 months must be presented at the time and entries are checked. Records that qualify for awards will be announced in The show ring following the judging of each class. In order to qualify each cow must have produced in the first 305 days of the lactation period the amount listed for each age.
5. Members must have owned cow during time covering records. DHIA Owner Sampler of Herd improvement records are ample.
6. Educational Exhibits are to be entered in DEPARTMENT 82 - Educational Projects/ Veterinary Science.
7. If class exceeds 10, class may be divided into equal groups for run-off where judge can select from each group for final winners.
8. Any changes in classes have to be made no later than 5:00 PM., Tuesday of fair. No changes can be made the day of show. Entries will be checked by Superintendent in charge.
9. Participation in SECTION 7—Dairy Cattle Showmanship is mandatory for all entered in Dept 2.
10. Refer to dress code on page 10, Rule #6.
